Welcome to PORTALGUARD.

If you are reading this handbook, you have either been assigned to support portal operations, selected for threshold safety training, or entrusted with command, policy, investigative, intelligence, medical, logistics, legal, or field responsibilities that intersect with GUARD portal infrastructure.

A portal is not a convenience. It is a controlled border, a security problem, a potential breach point, and in the wrong conditions, a disaster site. PORTALGUARD exists because GUARD learned that a doorway can move medical teams and humanitarian aid with astonishing speed - and that same doorway can also become an incursion route, a floodgate, a smuggling corridor, or an uncontrolled first-contact event.

Study this handbook with professional seriousness. PORTALGUARD is a scientific division, but it is not a laboratory club. It is an operational command built around disciplined curiosity, technical precision, and containment before discovery.

I have opened doors I did not understand. That is not an admission of failure; it is the first honest sentence every portal scientist should be required to say aloud.

PORTALGUARD is not built to chase the impossible recklessly. It is built to make the possible safe, to support GUARD response across Earth, and to ensure that the unknown is approached with systems, safeguards, witnesses, and people empowered to say no.

When you stand in a portal bay, remember Barcelona. Remember the red-ocean incident. Remember that the far side of a doorway may not be hostile and still may be lethal. Know the doctrine. Trust the team. Respect the threshold.

How to Use This Handbook

This handbook is designed as an internal GUARD orientation and doctrine guide. It should be read in order on first issue, then retained as a reference document.

Sections I-IV establish the mission, science, history, and operational logic of PORTALGUARD. Sections V-VIII define the facility, security, incident, and coordination requirements. Sections IX-XI identify organization, training, and commander-level orientation. Appendices provide quick-reference material for field orientation, academy training, and command review.

This handbook is not a substitute for live certification, portal bay supervision, classified annexes, or Special Threat Command authorization.

Section I. PORTALGUARD Mission and Identity

PORTALGUARD is GUARD's specialized portal operations, portal security, portal engineering, and threshold-containment division. It operates under GUARD Global Operations Command through Special Threat Command.

Its mission is to develop, operate, secure, and regulate GUARD-controlled portal systems for rapid Earth-based response while containing, studying, and defending against unstable portal events, dimensional anomalies, and unauthorized threshold breaches.

Division Identity

- Operational portals are Earth-to-Earth only and require two approved anchors.
- Stable portal transit is a controlled border crossing, not casual transportation.
- Experimental non-Earth openings remain classified, unstable, and not reliably repeatable.
- PORTALGUARD is science-based, but it coordinates with MYSTIGUARD when magical resonance or mystical threshold behavior is detected.
- Every portal is treated as a potential breach point until secured and verified.

Primary Mission Areas

Mission Area	Purpose
Earth-Based Portal Transit	Move authorized GUARD personnel, emergency teams, medical staff, cargo, and crisis resources between approved GUARD facilities.
Portal Infrastructure Security	Protect portal anchors, portal rings, route files, network systems, power systems, and receiving-side controls.
Portal Incident Response	Respond to malfunctions, unscheduled activations, environmental breaches, hostile crossings, and destination drift.
Threshold Science and Research	Study unstable portal events, threshold resonance, non-Earth signatures, and Barcelona/red-ocean incident data.
Mystical Portal Coordination	Coordinate with MYSTIGUARD on magical resonance, Earth-bound mystical portals, artifact-linked thresholds, and technomagic concerns.

Section II. Science and Portal Doctrine

PORTALGUARD portal technology creates controlled threshold corridors, not teleportation beams. A portal is a temporary doorway between two real locations, allowing matter, energy, atmosphere, sound, light, organisms, and hazards to pass both ways while open.

Core Scientific Terms

Term	Definition
Anchor	Fixed portal station used to stabilize one side of a portal connection.
Aperture	The visible portal opening.
Threshold Corridor	The temporary passage formed between two portal points.
Threshold Resonance	Measurable energy signature created by portal activation.
Destination Lock	Confirmed portal connection to the intended receiving anchor.
Anchor Refusal	Receiving anchor rejects or blocks connection.
Threshold Lag	Mild physical disorientation after portal transit.
Destination Drift	Portal connects to an unintended location.
Environmental Breach	Atmosphere, liquid, heat, organisms, or hazardous matter crosses through.
Hard Seal	Emergency physical isolation of the portal chamber.
Blind Opening	Any opening to an unverified or unanchored destination.
Receiving Veto	Receiving-side operator blocks a portal from opening.
Network Contamination	Fault, intrusion, or anomaly threatens linked anchors.
Perse Event	Informal internal phrase for unexpected non-Earth threshold contact.

Doctrine Rules

- Stable operational portals require two approved, mapped, secured, and actively monitored anchors.
- The operational portal network is physically, digitally, and procedurally separated from the experimental portal systems.
- Portal bays are containment facilities and controlled border crossings, not simple transit rooms.
- AI monitors safety and may initiate emergency shutdown during catastrophic conditions, but AI cannot independently open experimental portals.
- MYSTIGUARD is notified when magical resonance or mystical threshold behavior is detected.
- The red-ocean incident permanently changed environmental-breach doctrine.

Section III. PORTALGUARD History

Origins: The Barcelona Breakthrough

PORTALGUARD began before it had a name. Dr. Vernon Perse, a quantum engineer and astrophysicist from Naples, Italy, constructed the first major portal system in Barcelona, Spain with financing from a secretive backer later connected to a major criminal organization.

The Barcelona system proved that threshold science was real. It also proved that the safeguards were not enough.

The Werewolf Incursion

During activation, Perse's second-ranking scientist disabled key safety systems. The portal opened to a werewolf-inhabited world, creating an uncontrolled breach. Werewolf beings crossed through, technicians were killed, and GUARD was forced to intervene.

GUARD contained the incursion, returned the werewolves, and helped destroy the original portal. Perse's missing second-ranking scientist remains an unresolved villain and gang-linked threat.

The GUARD Accord

GUARD allowed portal research to continue under strict GUARD authority because the technology was too dangerous to ignore, too useful to abandon, and too strategically significant to leave in private or criminal hands. This agreement became the GUARD Accord and the foundation of PORTALGUARD.

Modern PORTALGUARD

PORTALGUARD now maintains 36+ operational Earth-to-Earth portal anchors. Beneath GUARD Headquarters in Boston, the division also controls three classified experimental portals, including the Satanazes Misclassification Portal, the Red-Ocean Event Portal, and the Unrepeatable Window Portal.

Section IV. Portal Operations and Network Doctrine

PORTALGUARD's operational network is the secure Earth-to-Earth portal backbone of GUARD. Its power comes from speed; its discipline comes from limits.

Operational Portal Classes

Class	Name	Description
P-1	Routine Earth Transit	Stable facility-to-facility movement of approved personnel or cargo.
P-2	Priority Operational Transit	Urgent movement for disaster response, medical evacuation, or crisis reinforcement.
P-3	Restricted Tactical Transit	Sensitive movement involving classified teams, detainees, artifacts, or high-risk equipment.
P-4	Portal Malfunction / Unscheduled Activation	Anchor instability, failed lock, unknown energy reading, or partial opening.
P-5	Unknown Threshold Event	Unverified destination, non-Earth indicator, magical resonance, or unknown organism intrusion.
P-6	Hostile Breach / Dimensional Incursion	Immediate threat to life, security, or containment.
P-7	Strategic Threshold Crisis	Portal network hijack, multi-site failure, mass-casualty breach, or planetary-level risk.

Transit Safety Rules

1. No portal opens without two-side confirmation unless under emergency breach protocol.
2. No unidentified biological matter passes without quarantine.
3. No unknown artifact passes without MYSTIGUARD or Artifact review.
4. No detainee moves through a portal without containment escort.
5. No experimental portal opens without Special Threat Command authorization.
6. No personnel enter an unknown portal without retrieval protocol.
7. No portal route remains active longer than operationally necessary.
8. No portal can override receiving-side lockdown.
9. No mystical portal is accessed without MYSTIGUARD liaison approval.
10. No scientist, commander, or field officer can bypass safeties alone.

Section V. Threshold Operations Complex and Facility Layout

PORTALGUARD's primary headquarters is the Threshold Operations Complex beneath GUARD Headquarters in Boston, Massachusetts. It is the division's command center, scientific heart, highest-security research site, and primary portal network control facility.

PG-3	Standard Operational Portal Bays	Secure Earth-to-Earth portal bays, transit lanes, cargo inspection, medical screening, hard-seal doors.

Section VI. Portal Security, Containment, and Incident Response

PORTALGUARD treats portal technology as both transportation infrastructure and a strategic threat system. A portal can deploy help, move supplies, evacuate casualties, bypass barriers, spread pathogens, introduce hostile organisms, or compromise multiple GUARD sites.

Standard Portal Site Security

- Armed PORTALGUARD security team and containment-trained response personnel.
- Biometric access control, two-person activation rule, and local lockdown authority.
- Remote command oversight, receiving-side confirmation, and receiving-side veto.
- Physical blast doors, decontamination systems, medical screening station, and cargo inspection zone.
- AI anomaly monitoring, cyber-defense firewall, manual hard-kill switch, and emergency evacuation route.
- MYSTIGUARD warding or liaison support where magical resonance is possible.

Portal Failure Types

Failure Type	Operational Meaning
Failed Ignition	Portal does not open; energy dissipates or safety lockout triggers.
Partial Aperture	Portal opens incompletely or asymmetrically; no transit permitted.
Anchor Refusal	Receiving anchor rejects the connection due to lockdown, damage, attack, or override.
Corridor Shear	Threshold corridor becomes unstable and may injure personnel or disrupt equipment.
Environmental Breach	Air, water, gas, heat, pathogens, radiation, or foreign matter crosses unexpectedly.
Biological Intrusion	Unauthorized organisms cross into the portal bay or containment zone.
Hostile Crossing	An intelligent or aggressive entity crosses through the aperture.
Destination Drift	Portal connects to an unintended location.
Recursive Feedback	Portal energy feeds back into itself, risking overload.
Network Contamination	Fault or intrusion threatens linked anchors or route files.

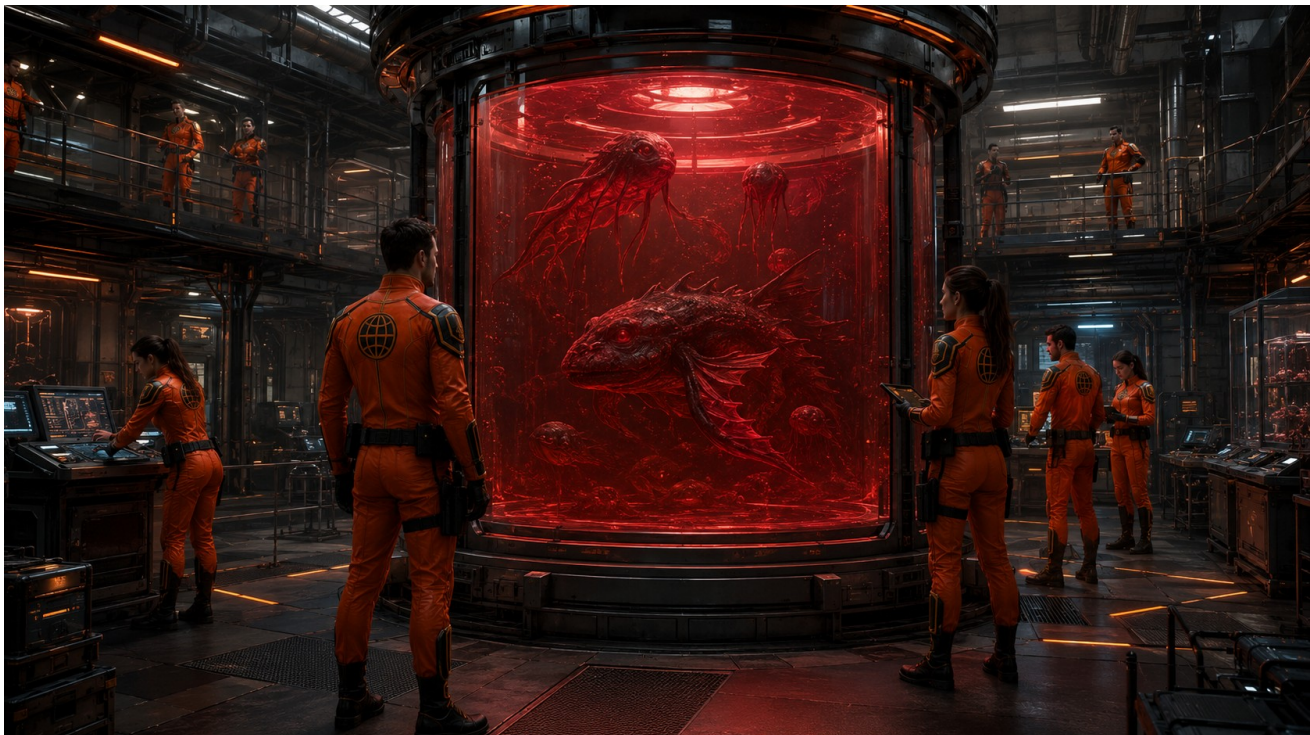
Section VII. Experimental Portals and Anomalous Threshold Events

The three experimental portals beneath GUARD HQ are not part of the routine operational network. They are classified research systems used to study unstable threshold phenomena, non-Earth signatures, and destination events that cannot yet be reliably reproduced.

Experimental Portal	Purpose / Known Association
Satanazes Misclassification Portal	Initially misidentified as a demon dimension; later confirmed with MYSTIGUARD as connection to Satanazes Isle. Used to study magic-physics interference and false dimensional readings.
Red-Ocean Event Portal	Opened briefly to a world or location with red-colored ocean water, flooding a portal bay and introducing alien aquatic organisms. Permanently changed environmental-breach doctrine.
Unrepeatable Window Portal	Opened fleeting windows to several unknown locations. None have been successfully reproduced. Major focus of Vernon Perse's unresolved research.

Experimental Activation Requirements

- Dr. Vernon Perse or approved senior portal scientist present or on authorized scientific review.
- PORTALGUARD operations authorization and Special Threat Command approval.
- Chief Threshold Safety Officer approval and containment/security officer approval.
- Independent AI safety verification.
- Medical/quarantine readiness and emergency shutdown team on station.
- MYSTIGUARD liaison when magical resonance is detected.
- ASTROGUARD liaison when off-world indicators appear.
- SSIIC notification for classified or security-sensitive events.

Section VIII. Cross-Division Coordination

PORTALGUARD does not operate in isolation. Portal events often cross GUARD domains: magical, alien, medical, security, intelligence, humanitarian, and tactical. Early coordination prevents avoidable escalation.

The guiding coordination rule is simple: PORTALGUARD measures, secures, stabilizes, and contains. Partner divisions classify, interpret, treat, investigate, or neutralize according to their domain authority.

Section IX. PORTALGUARD Organization and Personnel Roles

PORTALGUARD is commanded by Dr. Vernon Perse, codenamed Door Man, who serves as Commander, Chief Portal Scientist, and founder of the division. His authority is intentionally checked by doctrine, review boards, and Special Threat Command oversight.

Major Branches

Branch	Core Responsibility
Command & Administration	Policy, staffing, clearance, legal compliance, budget, training records, and division administration.
Portal Operations	Daily use of the Earth-to-Earth portal network, route control, transit manifests, and receiving-side coordination.
Portal Engineering & Maintenance	Portal hardware, anchor calibration, power systems, gateway frames, aperture stabilization, and repairs.
Threshold Science & Research	Portal theory, experimental analysis, threshold resonance, destination drift, and non-Earth event reconstruction.
Containment & Portal Security	Physical security, portal bay defense, breach suppression, detainee transfer security, and hard-seal procedures.
Medical, Quarantine & Exposure	Medical screening, biological exposure, alien organism handling, pathogen risk, and threshold lag monitoring.
Portal Logistics & Emergency Movement	Movement of personnel, cargo, relief supplies, emergency equipment, and critical assets.

Section X. Training, Certification, and Academy Alignment

PORTALGUARD training is designed for three audiences: GUARD officers who must understand portal capabilities and restrictions, new PORTALGUARD personnel who must qualify for operations, and advanced GUARD Academy cadets aligned to portal operations, engineering, logistics, security, or special-threat pathways.

Core Training Requirements

- Portal Safety Orientation: every portal is a border crossing and potential breach point.
- Anchor Doctrine and Route Control: stable portals require approved two-anchor destination locks.
- Portal Bay Conduct: movement lanes, restricted zones, hard-seal procedures, and kill-station awareness.
- Transit Manifest Discipline: personnel, cargo, detainees, medical loads, artifacts, and hazardous materials.
- Containment Before Curiosity: scientific data gathering never outranks life safety and containment.
- Emergency Shutdown and Evacuation: immediate actions during aperture instability, environmental breach, or hostile crossing.
- Cross-Division Escalation: when to notify MYSTIGUARD, ASTROGUARD, Medical, SSIIC, Intelligence, XGUARD, or Logistics.
- Ethics and Legal Controls: lawful use of portal transit, detainee movement, evidence chains, and humanitarian access.

Section XI. Commander Vernon Perse / Door Man



Dr. Vernon Perse / Door Man, Commander of PORTALGUARD and Chief Portal Scientist.

Doctor Vernon Perse is the founder, commander, and chief portal scientist of PORTALGUARD. A brilliant quantum engineer and astrophysicist from Naples, Italy, Perse developed the threshold science that made GUARD's Earth-based portal network possible.

Vernon is likable, distracted, intense, curious, and famously difficult to keep focused on anything less interesting than whatever equation is currently running through his head. He is not a conventional military commander. He is a founder-scientist whose genius created the field he now governs and whose worst failure shaped the safety doctrine that prevents PORTALGUARD from becoming reckless.

Leadership Boundaries

- Perse leads PORTALGUARD scientifically and strategically.
- He cannot unilaterally activate high-risk experimental portals.
- He cannot bypass no-solo-opening safeguards.
- Daily portal route authorization, security enforcement, quarantine release, and network cybersecurity clearance are shared through disciplined branch authority.
- These limits are not a lack of trust in his intelligence; they recognize that intelligence and judgment are not the same thing.

Character Summary for Officers and Cadets

Vernon Perse opened the door to PORTALGUARD's future, but GUARD makes sure he never opens it alone. Personnel assigned to his command should respect his genius, support his scientific focus, and understand the safety structures that keep the division disciplined.
