UNRESOLVED COMPLAINTS SUPPLEMENTAL FILE

Representative Incidents

- **14 Aug 2024:** Citizen complaint of chemical odor near a rural access road west of Bismarck; tire impressions photographed; no active tanker present on arrival.
- **07 Nov 2024:** Patrol officer noted Altona-marked vehicle stopped at an unauthorized turnout; driver stated route confusion and departed after warning.
- **19 Feb 2025:** Anonymous call alleged that paperwork for a northbound tanker convoy had been 'fixed after the fact.' No supporting documents furnished.
- **02 Jul 2025:** Field note described discoloration near drainage ditch adjacent to a temporary holding area. Sampling recommendation forwarded to state agency.
- **28 Jan 2026:** Interviewee claimed a supervisor referenced money movement through subcontractors 'to keep certain friends happy.' Identity of speaker not independently verified.

Pattern Analysis

No individual incident independently establishes criminal conduct; however, the frequency of odor complaints, route anomalies, missing paperwork, and overlapping agency referrals supports the view that Altona-related traffic merits continued observation. Multiple complainants withdrew or declined formal statements after later contact by private attorneys.

Administrative Note

Investigators are advised to preserve photographs, body-camera extracts, and dispatch notes. Counsel for Altona frequently requests copies early in the complaint cycle. Coordination with higher-level agencies is recommended when organized-crime indicators appear.
